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1. Installation of Bolt+ On Web

2. Login Screen and FasT Keys


Right Click & Open or Double click on the Bolt+ On Web Icon on your desktop:



Application is started / launched as below:



Login Screen:







Enter the User Id, Password & Transaction Password.

For initial login, procurement of new user Id & passwords, kindly contact your administrator/member/broker.

Get Authentication Image:

Each user is assigned with an unique Image for the purpose of Login.

This enables a two factor authentication process for the security of the user's account/ld.

To get the image the Users e-mail id must be registered on the Bolt+ On Web Admin > User details segment.

User enters his login Id and clicks on the option, the unique Image is sent to the Users registered email Id.

Download this unique image & select it through **Browse** button.

Retain Last Login Info:

This option when selected, the user will not have to re-enter the login id on his next login attempt as it would remember the last login Id.

Client Master:

This master downloads all the users mapped under the Id. This is optional download in case there is no change in the Users in the system, but has to be done compulsorily on first login.

Script Master:


This option downloads the latest Scrip/contract master. This is optional download, but has to be done compulsorily on first login.

Client Master and Script Master can alternatively also be downloaded after logging into Bolt+ On Web from the below Option:








3. MarketWatch / Touchline

Go to the Dropdown >> File Menu >> MarketWatch option Short Key: Cntrl + W

Click on Delete to Delete the selected MarketWatch






Click on Import MW to import MarketWatch saved from Bolt+ On Web terminal




4. How to Create New MarketWatch / Touchline: Short Key: Cntrl + W

Click on New, and Select as shown below:







Once Created Click on Save to complete.

5. Overview of the MarketWatch:



- Short Keys: This option provides the user with short keys to Lock the Terminal, Re-Connect, Disconnect, Hide Menu & Log Out
- Menu: The menu bar shows the options available to the User of the trading application.






- Toolbar: Contains all the frequently used functionalities and reports that are used by the user under the selected Menu option.
- Open Tabs: All the windows that have been kept open by the user are shown in this space.
- MW Header: Market watch header is the columns currently selected by the user for the market watch.
- Scrips\Contracts: These are the scrip's / contracts that the user has added to his market watch for live price watch and order placement.
- Exchange Messages: This Board provides the user with details of data provided by the Exchange as Broadcast Messages.
- Message Board: Here the user will be able to view all the order/trade confirmations, any information flashed by the Exchanges and information provided / communicated to the user by the member.
- Status Bar: This bar would provide the user with some essential information regarding Current Date, Version, Last Login & time, Login Id, Login Name, etc.
- Index board: Here the user can add the available indices including the sector indices.

The trading Application interface has been made to be as easily accessible as possible, with the availability of keyboard controls and easy access to commonly used functions so that the speed of access and usability could be increased.

6. How to Add Scrips / Contracts: Short key F4


User can add contracts and scrips using the below options.


F4: User can add scrips / contracts one by one by entering the Equity scrip code, name or symbol. Also Equity and currency derivatives can be added from the same option





F11: User can add multiple scrips / contracts by using this option. **Press F11:**





7. How to Buy/Sell:

Short Key: F1 or "+" / F2 or "-"

Buy: To place Buy order(s) the user can click on Buy option .Also, the user can use the Keyboard "+" or "F1" keys.

Sell: To place Sell order(s) the user can click on Sell option .Also, the user can use the Keyboard "-" or "F2" keys.



8. View Pending orders: Order Book – Short Key- F3 & Double F3



The list of pending orders with the details like Symbol, Quantity, Price, Buy/Sell, Order No, Exchange, Client ID, User/Admin ID, time of order, etc. can be viewed from here.

Right click on the order book- Select Columns - enables the user to view additional fields by selecting the required columns.

The order details can be saved in text file.





The user is also provided with the flexibility to select and position the column according to choice. Right Click on the Order book, Chose the option "Select Column". This will open a window showing the list of columns available for selection. Use the "UP" and "DOWN" Arrow keys to change the positioning of the columns.

After selection of the columns, click on "Save" button to save the changes.




The Search Panel helps the Admin to filter down to the finest level of details of the pending orders.

The orders can be filtered from Exchange/ Market/Segment to Login id / Symbol/ series /inst. Name/ Expiry/ Opt. Type.

Also, the trades can be filtered for the type of Orders like – Buy /Sell, Intraday/ Delivery.

If any kind of Batch orders is to be sent to the exchange, the same are uploaded using the Bulk order facility online and the same can be viewed from the Batch Orders dropdown and then released, one by one or all at a time.


Alternatively the user can right click on the scrip in the Marketwatch and select the below option view order details for <Scrip/Contract>







9. View Executed Trades: Trade Book Short Key – F8 & double F8




The list of traded/Executed orders with the details of Symbol, Quantity, Price, value Buy/Sell, Order Number, Trade Number, Exchange, User ID, time of trade is available in this book.

Right click on the Trade book - Select Columns - enables the user to view additional fields by selecting the required columns. All the details can be saved in a Text file or exported to an Excel.

The user is also provided with the flexibility to select and position the column according to choice. Right Click on the Trade book, Chose the option "Select Column".

This will open a window showing the list of columns available for selection. Use the "UP" and "DOWN" Arrow keys to change the positioning of the columns. After selection of the columns, click on "Save" button to save the changes.



The Search Panel helps the user to filter down to the finest level of details of the executed orders.






The trades can be filtered from Exchange/ Market/Segment to Login id / Symbol/ series /inst. Name/ Expiry/ Opt. Type.

The trades can be filtered for the type of Orders like – Buy /Sell, Intraday/ Delivery. The user is also provided with the option of filtering the Trades in a Time Range.

Alternatively the user can right click on the scrip in the Marketwatch and select the below option view trade details for <Scrip/Contract>:



10. View Net Position: Net Position Book Short keys –F9 & Double F9



F9 will display the Net position for users in the scrip's/ contracts in which Trades has been done or have brought forward positions in the same.

This report provides the user with its Net Position in the system. The same details can be filtered down to multiple layers as shown above. The Net Position book can be divided into sections like Search panel and View panel.







View Panel – This option reflects the days Open Positions brought forward & carry forward positions (Click on the Respective tick box).

It shows the day's open position with the details of client, symbol, buy quantity, average buy price, buy value, sell quantity, average sell price, sell value, current market price, Mark to Market, Profit/Loss.

If the User setting is set to Auto Refresh, then the Admin will be able to view the Net position along with the MTM+PL, CMP on a live basis.

The user is also provided with the flexibility to select and position the column according to user's preference. Right Click on the Net position book, Chose the option "Select Column". This will open a window showing the list of columns available for selection. Use the "UP" and "DOWN" Arrow keys to change the positioning of the columns. After selection of the columns, click the "Save" button to save the changes.

The Search Panel helps the user to filter down to the finest level of details of the Net position of User(s).

It can be filtered from Exchange/Market/Segment to Login id / Symbol/series /inst. Name/Expiry/Opt. Type. The trades also can be filtered for the type of Orders like – Buy /Sell, Intraday/Delivery.




Brought Forward – These are the positions that are being brought forward from the previous trading days. It will be visible only if the positions of the users from the previous days are uploaded.

Days Position – These are the intra-day positions taken by the user.

Carry forward – This indicates the Net position of the user in the particular scrip / contract whether it is net long or net short.

Alternatively the user can right click on the scrip in the Marketwatch and select the below option view Net Position details for <Scrip/Contract>











This report provides the user with the Log of all the activities carried out. This includesorder confirmation, rejection, cancellation of orders, Trade confirmation and the rejected orders of all types with the reject reason.

This Allows the user to View the list of activity at any given time during the day by with details of Symbol, series, Order Number, Volume, Buy/Sell, Trigger Price, Activity, Time, Intra/Del, User ID, account Type.

Right Click on the screen - Select Columns - enables the user to view additional fields by selecting the required columns. The activity log details can be saved in text file or the same can be exported to an Excel sheet.



The Search Panel helps the user to filter down to the finest level of details of the Activity Log of User(s).

The orders can be filtered from Exchange/ Market/Segment to Login id / Symbol/ series /inst. Name/ Expiry/ Opt. Type.

Also, the trades can be filtered for the type of Orders like – Buy /Sell, Intraday/ Delivery.
The user can specifically view only the Rejected Orders by clicking on the Rejected orders option on the Search Panel.





12. Market Depth: Best 5

The User will be able to get the BEST 5 prices in the market for the scrip selected.

It will provide the user apart from the BEST 5, other important details like LTP, LTQ, Volume, Value, ATP (Avg. Traded Price), DPR (Daily Price Range), Chg, Open, High, Low, % Chg.


In case scrip is not added in the Market watch, the user can enter the symbol, Symbol code in the Symbol/Script space and Press enter, and the user would receive the details for that particular scrip.

And if the user wants to place the order in the same scrip, user can use the order entry keys to the orders directly in the selected scrip of the MBP without adding it to the Market watch.





13. Margins:




This window enables the users to view their margin details. These details include Actual deposit given, Adhoc Deposit, Equity collateral, Derivatives collateral, currency collateral/L, Eq. Sales, Used deposit and Available deposit.

All the above can be viewed as per Category, Exchange, Market, and Segment, provided the deposit has been provided in the mentioned manner.

Also, the details of the deposit can be seen in the Margin Details window in the lower section.

Here the user can view the positions in which the deposit is used, P/L booked, and any kind of Eq. Sales if any done, in which security / contract, Exchange.

14. User Stock: Short Key: Cntrl + D








The user will be able to view his holdings in his DP in this link. The holdings will be visible only if the member/Broker uploads the holdings in Bolt+ On Web.

The user will be able to view the Stock, Stock Name, DP/Pool holding if any, Previous Settlements, Today Sell (If any stock sold today), Net available (after deducting the sold positions if any for the day), CMP (Current Market Price of the stock), & the Current value of his stock at CMP.

Apart from the above the user would be able to enter his Purchase price and therefore user can view the P/L on his portfolio.

The user if wants to sell out of the holdings, user will have to select the Delivery option, while selling.



The user can also perform the below functions such as Copy selected rows , Save settings , Save to text file, open Market Watch for Scrips & Set Bought Price(Buy Price)

15. Batch Orders

Batch Orders is a feature which helps the users to create/enter orders manually or upload .csv or .txt file of various types of orders– Buy, Sell, Intraday, Delivery, IOC, EOTODY, EOSESS, etc and also place orders in various market segments like Equity, Derivatives & Currency.

These orders can be also created in an Excel / Notepad separately and be saved as a .csv or .txt files and uploaded in the format provided.

Once the orders have been entered manually or a file is uploaded in the pre-requisite format, the same orders are then visible through the Order Book Batch orders option.

These orders can be modified or cancelled if not to be released in live market. Once the orders are all good to be released they can be released all at one go or one order at a time.







If executed these orders would reflect in Trade and Net position. And if not executed will reflect in the Normal Order book option as a pending order.

Below is the view of Batch Order Entry:

Orders can be entered manually or can be uploaded through the Upload Orders option.



Once the file is uploaded and saved. The orders can be viewed in the Order Book (F3) option of Batch Orders.



These orders can then be Modified, Cancelled or released one at a time or all together.

Once released they will be visible in the Normal Order Book / Trade Book / Net position as per execution status.

16. Net Position (Trade Wise):

Incase the user is facing issues in viewing the Net Position from F9 / Net position, user can use this alternate option where Net position is provided as a summary/view of the Trade Book.















17.14 Alerts:

This option helps the user to generate Multiple Alerts for scripts / contracts.

Right Click on the Script/Contract





The Alert can be created as shown above.
Once the parameters are met, Alerts would be generated.







Once the Alert is generated it again provides the user with following features:

Go to Script: Focus of the cursor is directed to the scrip / contract for which the Alert has been generated.

Show Details: This would open the Alert Page for the selected scrip/contract.

Delete Alert: This option Delete's the Alert generated.


Close Alert: By clicking on this option, the Alert would be closed.

Close All Alerts: This option helps the user in closing all alerts in a single click.





18 User Settings General Settings



Auto Refresh Order/Trade/Net Books:

This can be enabled if the user requires the Order book, Trade book & Net Position book to refresh automatically when the order is entered, or when the order is gets executed. If the user requires the Order book, Trade book & Position book to be updated only when he manually refreshes then this can be Unchecked.

Lock Order/Trade/Net Position Books:

If the user does not want the Order/Trade/Net Position books to close on the use of ESC key then user can utilize this option. If the user wants to close these books, User can press the close button.

Highlighted Decimal from right (For Currency):

This feature is used by traders who are trading in the currency market as the movement of the contract is active in the last two digits after the decimal point most of the trading times. So the dealer can highlight the required digits after the decimal point as highlighted as this would ease the viewing and quicken the time of order entry for him.

Do not Close MW on Terminal Lock:

The system automatically locks the Terminal when the set time is exceeded, and the MW does not close. If the user wants to hide the MW when it is locked, he can uncheck this option.

Auto Refresh MTM in Net Position:

This feature helps the user to check the MTM (Mark to Margin) of the open position(s), on a real time basis.

Show Square Off Buttons in Net Position Book:





The user can square off all the open positions of all users or any individual using this option. Before squaring off the system would automatically cancel all the pending positions of the user (s). The user can also partially square off the positions of the user (s).

Show Cancel All Buttons in Order Book:

This option allows the user to cancel all the pending orders in the order book for all the user(s).

Show Admin Pop Ups:

All messages sent by Admin are broadcast to the user as a pop-up and also shown in the message board.

Disable Cancel/Square off confirmation Pop Ups:

On Cancel & Square off, of the order & trade the system can be enabled to ask for confirmation as a pop-up to confirm the action taken by the user.

Save Windows Location and State:

On enabling this Bolt+ On Web saves the window location and state of Order Book , Trade Book & Net Position.

Display Selected Contract while Adding:

This shows the selected contact while adding the same.

Indices Font:



Users can change the font type, style, size of the Indices as Required.

Show Floating Indices Board:

This option allows the user to keep his indices in floating mode i.e., the indices board can be moved and placed anywhere in the market watch.

Show Single Line Message Panel:

The Message confirmation box can be reduced to a single line view which allows more space in the market watch/ touchline. All the trade confirmations, exchange messages, admin messages will remain the same, only the space utilization has been reduced to a single line.

Show Exchange Messages on Login:

This option provides the Exchange Message Board on login with live update of messages displayed by the Exchange

Apply User Custom Colors & Fonts:

This option allows the user to set the color and font settings for the message confirmations as per user requirements.

Resizable Main Window:

This option allows the user to re-size the window as per requirement.

Auto Open Exchange Time:


This option allows the user to view the exchange time, status whether open or close and also the time remaining for the open and close of the exchange in HH:MM:SS format.





Adjust Script Search Speed (Slow.....Fast) :

This allows the user to adjust the speed for script/contract search while typing. For slow typists the speed can be selected as slow and for fast typists it can be selected as fast.



Interest Rate:

Once updated this information is used in the option calculator for calculation of various options.

Dividend Rate:

Once updated this information is used in the option calculator for calculation of various options.

The user is able to set his maximum order quantity, Value and Minimum order quantity. Here the user settings cannot supersede the main admin.

--Maximum Order Quantity

This is the maximum order quantity that the user can enter in a single order entry. If the user enters quantity which is above the maximum quantity the user will get an alert pop-up that the quantity is above the set limit and if he wants to continue he can press yes/ok.

--Maximum Order Value





This is the maximum order Value that the user can enter in a single order entry. If the user enters an order which is above the maximum Value the user will get an alert pop-up that the value is above the set limit and if he wants to continue he can press yes/ok.

--Minimum Order Quantity

This is the minimum order quantity that the user can enter in a single order entry. If the user enters quantity which is below the minimum quantity the user will get an alert pop-up that the quantity is below the set limit and if he wants to continue he can press yes/ok. The minimum quantity has to be 1.

Order Confirmation

These are additional customization available to customize the default order entry behavior.

--Control on Order Entry

This sets the default Order Entry Acceptance and Confirmation behavior to Enter and Ctrl. If the user does not want to customize his order entry keys then he can check this option and when he is placing the order he will first press the enter key and then the control key to place the order. If the user does not want to use two keys he can uncheck this option and then the user will be able to place the order only by pressing the Enter key.

--Customized Order Entry Keys

This allows the user to change the acceptance and confirmation keys for Order Entry.



This means End of Settlement. In this type of order the placed will be valid till the end of expiry of the particular contract and will get executed if the price is achieved anytime in the expiry period or will be cancelled if not executed at the end of the expiry.

Enable Retain Client

When a dealer is placing orders for multiple users, the dealer can select this option as this will retain the client code used to place order the last time.

Set BackOffice Id as Blank

This option will set the back office id blank, if the dealer is punching in orders for multiple users.

In the event of any order getting traded or any order getting triggered the user will get a beep sound from the system speakers.

Show Symbol Color if Net Change

If, there is a net change in the symbol on the market watch, the symbol will also change using the colors set in the market watch.

Default Values

Bolt+ On Web is context aware in execution this means that if the user presses any specific key in any window the behaviour of Bolt+ On Web changes accordingly. Like Pressing F1 or + changes selects the Script/Contract for the active window, or pressing F2 / - automatically selects the best available price. This behaviour can be overridden by setting default values.

NOTE: THIS IS RECOMMENDED TO ONLY ADVANCED USERS WHO TRADE ONLY IN LIMITED EXCHANGES/SCRIPTS/CONTRACTS AS THIS CHANGES THE SYSTEMS DEFAULT BEHAVIOR.

The default values for the values in Bolt+ On Web like Quantity, price etc. can be set here.

This is the default protection percentage the user would require in his order panel when placing any trade into the system whether it is buy or sell.

Default Select Pro Client If Applicable

If the user is placing orders into the system on behalf of the broker/ organization and wants to select the orders to be by default as proprietary trades then the user can select this option. This option sets the default as PRO orders in the order entry panel.

Set SrcipWise Default Order Value

The option provides the user flexibility to define multiple default values upto the Expiry level of the Contracts.

E.g. If the user wants to have one set default value to be defined for USD contract for August and different set of values for September to be populated on every order entry, the user can use this option to define the Default values
